

## **NOTICE OF START OF CONSTRUCTION FOR HARLEM RIVER BULKHEAD PENETRATION FOR CHAMPLAIN HUDSON POWER EXPRESS**

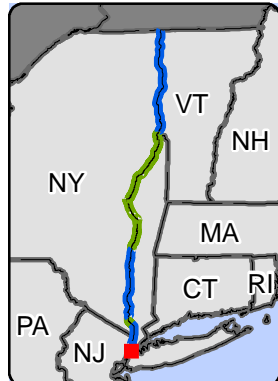
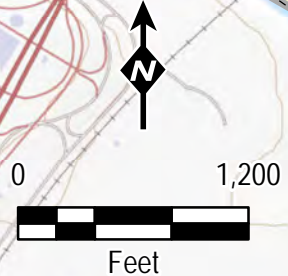
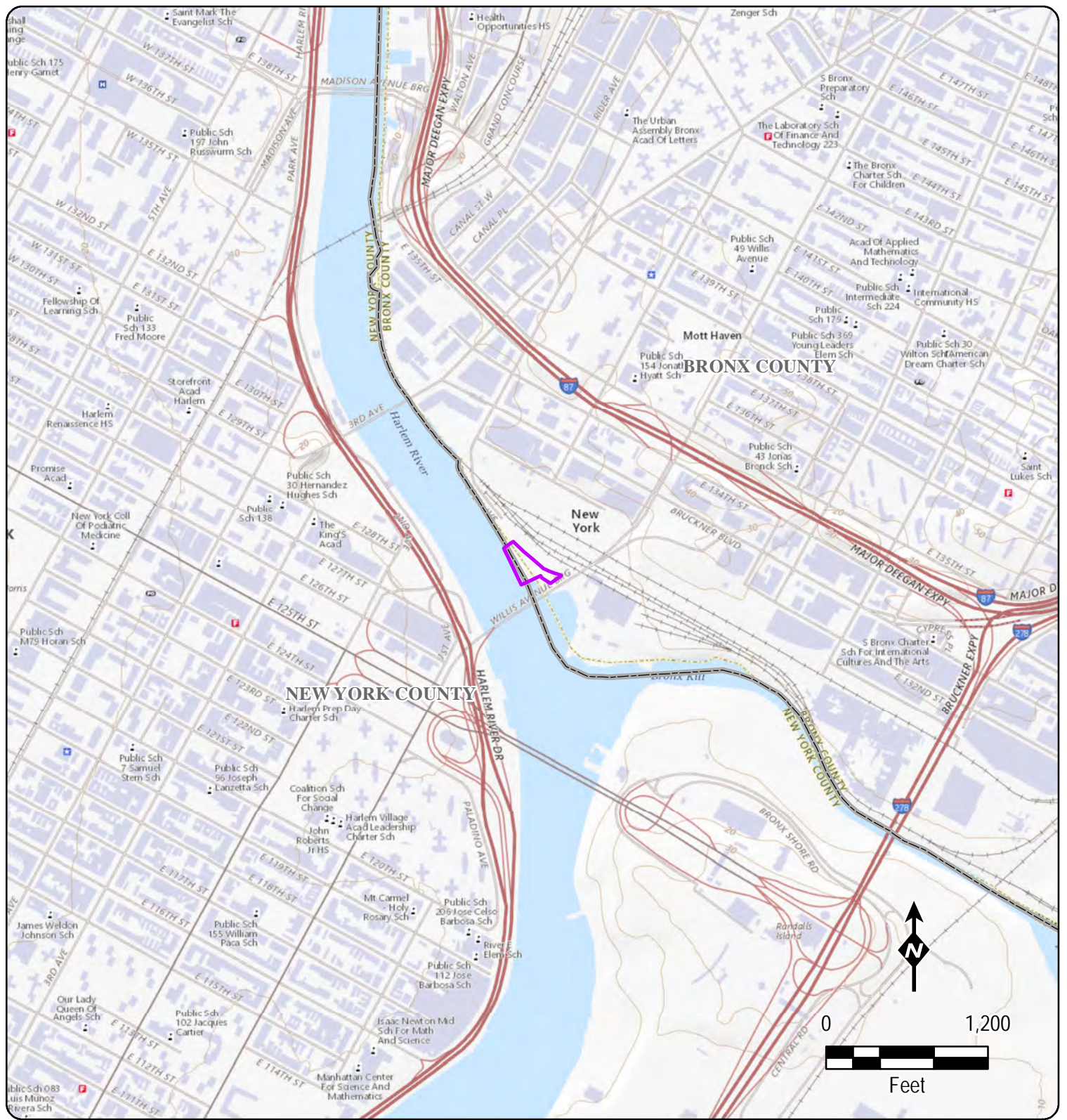
Please take notice that, on or about October 1, 2024, CHPE, LLC and CHPE Properties, Inc. (collectively referred to as “CHPE” or “Certificate Holders”) intend to commence work on the Segment 20A, Harlem River Bulkhead Penetration Segment, of the proposed Champlain Hudson Power Express (“CHPE”) Project, pursuant to the Environmental Management & Construction Plan (“EM&CP”) approved by the New York State Public Service Commission (“Commission”) on August 15, 2024. Work on this Segment will be limited to a parcel at 98 Lincoln Avenue, and a limited adjacent area in the Harlem River, which is located in an industrial area in the Port Morris neighborhood of the Bronx, through the end of 2024.

On April 18, 2013, the NYS Public Service Commission (Commission) issued to CHPE a certificate of environmental compatibility and public need (Certificate), pursuant to Article VII of the Public Service Law (PSL), to construct and operate the CHPE Project. The Certificate requires that, prior to construction of any portion of the Project, CHPE disseminate construction notices to the public and obtain a Notice to Proceed with Construction from the New York State Department of Public Service staff.

The scope of work for this Segment includes the installation of a temporary cofferdam and penetration of a bulkhead to facilitate installation of conduits, as well as duct bank construction on the northern shore of the Harlem River. An overview map of the proposed route is attached hereto. Given the seasonal restrictions applicable to portions of this work, activities will occur on a 7-day-per-week basis, inclusive of Sundays and holidays, through December 2024 to facilitate timely and efficient installation of the Facility. Construction will generally occur during daylight hours; should nighttime operations be needed, due to scheduling, safety and/or operational needs, CHPE will seek appropriate authorizations from City and State regulators and will employ appropriate noise suppression and impact mitigation measures.
