Re: Case 10-T-0139: Application of Champlain Hudson Power Express

Dear Secretary Phillips:

Enclosed please find the Environmental Management and Construction Plan (EM&CP) for Segment 19B, Hudson River Cable Installation, of the electric transmission project known as Champlain Hudson Power Express ("CHPE" or the "Project"). This EM&CP is submitted by CHPE LLC and CHPE Properties, Inc. (together the "Certificate Holders") in accordance with the requirements of CHPE's April 18, 2013 Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need ("Certificate"), issued pursuant to Article VII of the Public Service Law ("PSL") by the New York State Public Service Commission (the "Commission").

The Project is a buried, High Voltage, Direct Current ("HVDC") transmission line extending approximately 339 miles from the New York/Quebec border to a converter station in Astoria, Queens. This EM&CP includes installation of approximately 89.1 miles of submarine cable installation in the Hudson River, divided into two subsegments. The first, the Cementon-Stony Point Hudson Marine Segment, is an approximately 67.5-mile installation beginning at the Hamlet of Cementon in the Town of Catskill (Greene County) and running along the bed of the Hudson River to the Town of Stony Point (Rockland County), connecting two Transitional Horizontal Directional Drill (HDD) locations in Cementon and Stony Point (Segments 17 and 16 of the Project, respectively). The second is the Congers-Harlem Hudson Marine Segment, an approximately 21.6-mile submarine segment running from the Congers HDD location in the Town of Clarkstown (Rockland County) (Segment 17 of the Project) along the bed of the Hudson River to the mouth of the Harlem River in New York City (Segment 20 of the Project).

The EM&CP provides detailed information regarding how this Segment of the Project will be constructed, the specific locations of cable installations, as well as descriptions of work to be performed, plan and profile drawings depicting the Project, and protocols to be used during construction to protect the community and the environment, and to comply with the CHPE Certificate. The EM&CP must be reviewed and approved by the PSC before construction on this Segment can begin.

The Certificate Holders have circulated notices related to this filing and will serve this filing in accordance with the Certificate. Notices will be published in the largest daily newspapers of general circulation within the region in which the proposed Segment is located. Notices will also be mailed to landowners near the proposed Segment, if any; posted to the project website; and circulated to Parties to this proceeding via upload to DMM. Proofs of service for notices and for dissemination of the EM&CP documents, including affidavits of publication in local newspapers, will be submitted under separate cover as soon as they are available.
